Unfortunately many deceptive step units have not been properly designed. Correctly built, deceptive steps are an incredible way to sneak a person on or off stage. Multiple effects such as vanishes, productions, and transformations are possible using this unique illusion principle.

any illusion such as the DeKolta Chair, vanishes and productions behind a cloth,

or any effect performed on top of the table where a person needs to appear, vanish, or change, can occur.

The steps themselves are made of the finest luan, and are covered with Formica type plastic laminate to give the sur-

face of the prop years of maintenance durability. The table is incredibly sturdy and features stout and yet removable aluminum legs and support structure. The tabletop is covered with thin carpeting material to expertly hide the trap.
